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# GECAC Adult Education Program



## About the Program

The Adult Education Program welcomes adults who are interested in gaining employment or attending college/ vocational training and need to improve their math, reading and English abilities, or are preparing for the GED test.

The classes are designed to meet the student's individual needs by increasing competency while providing opportunities to learn about careers and employment.

## The Classes

**Adult Education Classes** For students needing basic skill instruction. The Adult Basic and GED Preparation Classes allow students to work toward their goals—passing the GED test, attending college/vocational training, getting a job or learning skills needed to be promoted.

**English Language Acquisition** For the student who needs to learn the English language. The class allows the students to learn and practice English in order to improve their daily lives, gain employment or enroll in Adult Basic Education classes.

**Transition Classes** For the student whose next step is college or vocational training. Two sessions of classes are offered in math and reading/writing skills.

**Volunteer Tutors** are available to work with students one on one or in small groups. Tutoring can be used with classes or alone depending on student need.

## Other Services

### Case Management

Students work with the Adult Education staff to set goals, examine potential opportunities and overcome the barriers to achieving them. Time is available outside of class to meet with staff individually, as needed. Adult Education staff follow up with students to encourage attendance and verify that goals are met.

### Career Pathways

All classes include career exploration and labor market information is integrated into the curriculum to help students prepare for the future.
