## About the Program

The Adult Education Program welcomes adults who are interested in gaining employment or attending college/ vocational training and need to improve their math, reading, and writing or are preparing for the GED test.

## How do I get started?

**Call the Adult Education Office at 814-459-4581 ext. 652 for an appointment.** All students must attend an orientation session.

At the session you will:

- ◆ Learn which classes are offered
- ◆ Take assessments to learn your skill level and get to know you better
- ◆ Meet with an adult education representative to see how the program can be of service to you
- ◆ Class locations and times

## Adult Education Classes

Classes are for students needing basic skill instruction. The Adult Basic Education and High School Equivalency Preparation classes allow students:

- ◆ Work toward completion of goals—passing the GED® or HiSet® tests
- ◆ Pass entrance exams
- ◆ Prepare for vocational training or college
- ◆ Gain employment
- ◆ Learn skills needed to be promoted or better employment.

## Case Management

Students work with the Adult Education staff to:

- ◆ set goals
- ◆ examine potential opportunities
- ◆ overcome the barriers to achieving them.

Time is available outside of class to meet with staff individually, as needed. Adult Education staff follow up with students to encourage attendance and verify students are achieving their goals.
