
Medicare Part D Comes to an End

The Medicare Annual Open Enrollment Period for Part D is coming to an end on December 7th. If you did not make changes to your plan and would still like to you may be able to do so. If, you are currently enrolled in a Medicare Advantage Plan.

- You can switch to another Medicare Advantage Plan with or without drug coverage.
- Drop your Medicare Advantage Plan and go back to Original Medicare.
- Join a Medicare drug plan.

If you receive Extra Help or have Medicaid, you may be able to make changes to your coverage one time during each of these periods: January-March, April-June, and July-September.


















LUNCH RESERVATIONS
